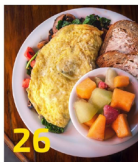

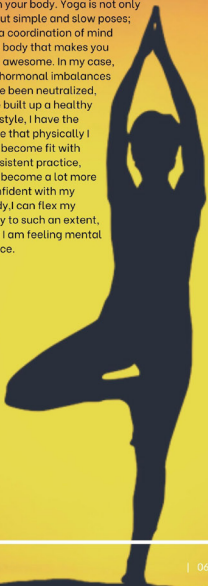
YOGA & MEDITATION

STRONG SEED

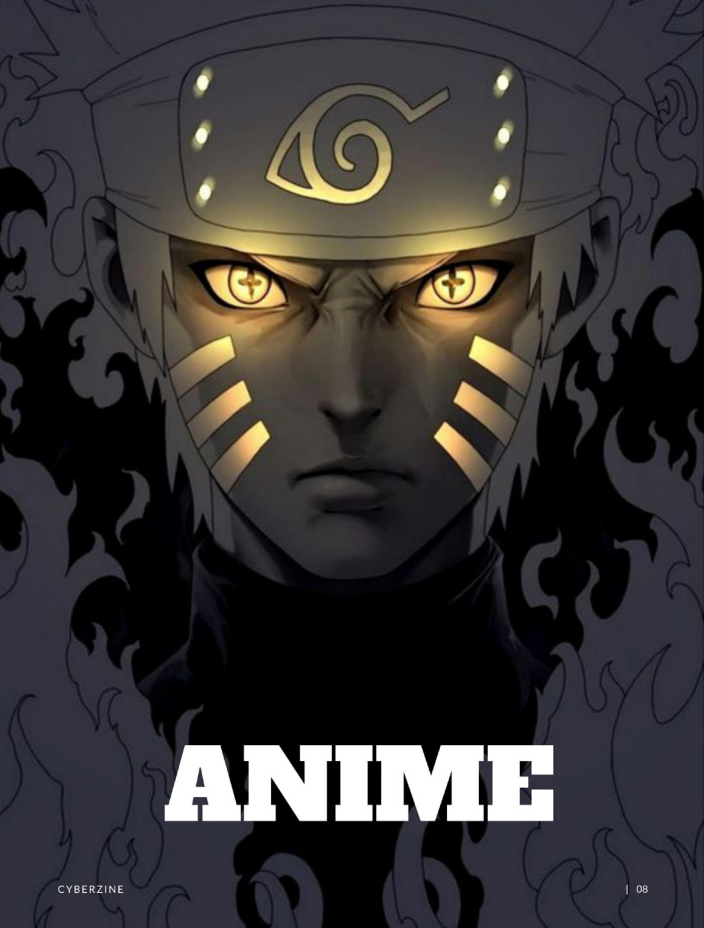

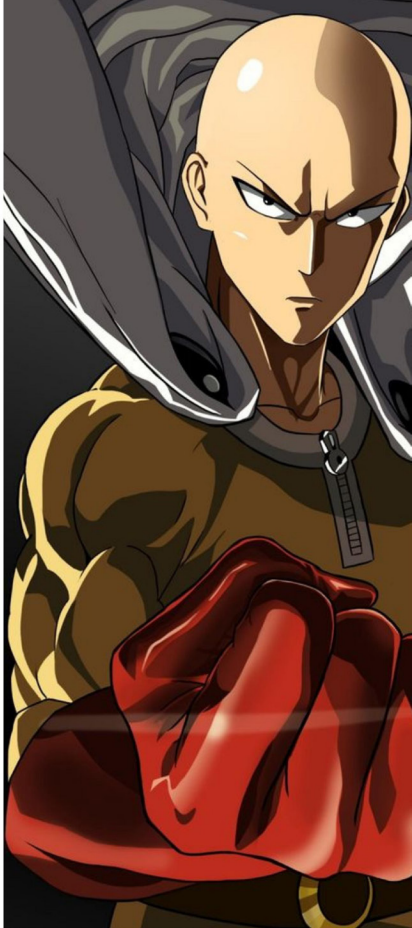

No, right!

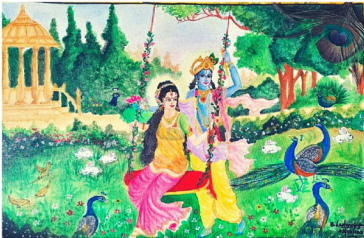

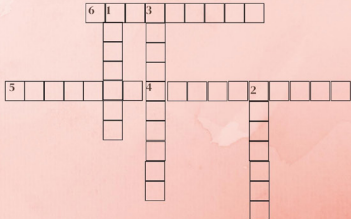

Kpop has become a global cultural phenomenon. South Korean pop music is known as K-pop. When you think of K-pop, you probably think of catchy songs, flashy music videos, dance moves, fashion, personalities, and choreography, but many people are unaware of what idols go through, such as suicides, harsh training, high standards, sasaengs, canceling idols, dating bans, depression, death threats, and soon.

Harsh training. The time they spent as trainees are what distinguishes K-pop. Agencies are under pressure to produce the most talented and beautiful idols possible to meet our expectations. Trainees take a risk in their lives that they will never be able to reverse. Companies hold auditions in various countries. Passing the audition is difficult. Some trainees work for entertainment agencies for years before making their debut. Some trainees begin their training at the age of 11. They have a tight schedule. It becomes even more difficult if they attend school. The training period varies from person to person. The average training period is 2 to 4 years. Jo Kwon debuted after 7 years of training, while Super Junior's Kyuhyun debuted after 3 months of training. They have monthly evaluations and their weights are checked regularly, but they celebrate being underweight, which is concerning.

Idols such as Goo Hara, Sulli, Jong-hyun, and Cha In Ha committed, exposing the dark side of K-pop. Depression, celebrity pressures, and death threats drove them to commit **suicide**.

Sasaengs are devoted followers who stalk or otherwise violate others' privacy. They can be as bad as committing crimes to get attention, breaking into people's homes and stealing their belongings or information, harassing their loved ones, and sending inappropriate gifts like lingerie. They can also form groups and succeed in getting jobs in the industry to get closer to their idols. The story of Taeyeon from Girls' Generation nearly being abducted on stage provides goosebumps.

Korea is known for its **unattainable beauty standards**. It makes sense that Korea is the center of plastic surgery. Only those with a slim build, small face, V-shape, jawline, pale complexion, double eyes, perfect skin, and big eyes are seen as attractive. Idols start eating poorly as a result of this. Some people are so insecure about not having the face they want that they even get plastic surgery. Idols are criticized for getting plastic surgery, although several idols have admitted to having it done.

Dating ban: Depending on their agencies, some people aren't allowed to date for a certain amount of time. Teenagers make up stories about their idols becoming their spouses because they make up the majority of the fans. As a result, when they start dating, fans feel misled and begin shocking the group. The businesses of the agencies would be lost. The dating prohibition is enforced quite strictly by some agencies. They have the power to expel someone from the organization.

Canceling culture: For idols to learn from their mistakes and stop others from making the same mistakes when they do anything wrong, they are canceled and receive backlash from fans. However, idol shows are being canceled these days for the silliest of reasons. 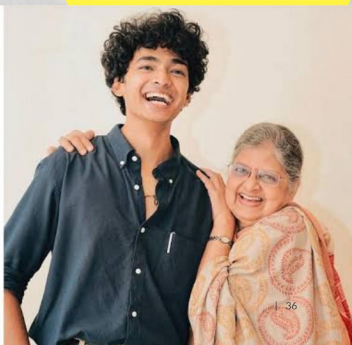
WHAT DO GOODFELLOWS DO?

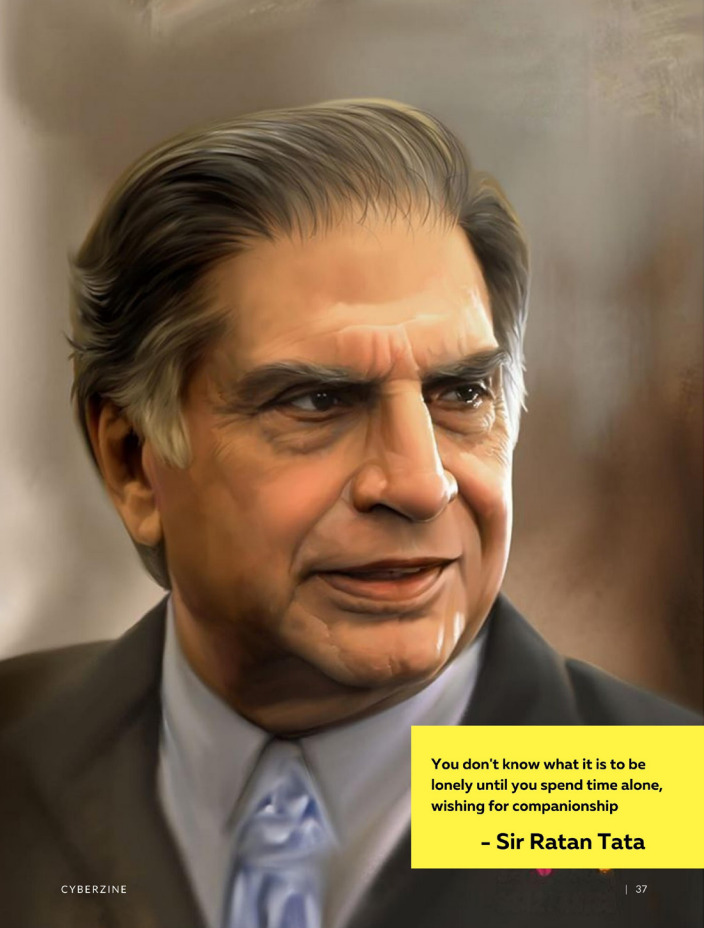
